1. Purpose of the report.

To request the Committee to consider finding a permanent home for the memorial stones currently housed in Barrow Primary School along with the placement of a Memorial Information Board.

2. Introduction.

At the Barrow Parish Council Meeting held on 13 November 2023, it was agreed that the Council's nominees to the Burial Committee would make enquires regarding the possibility of the memorial stones currently stored in Barrow Primary School, having a permanent home in the cemetery, along with the placement of a Memorial Information Board.

3. Background.

The Burial Committee may not be aware that there are numerous memorial stones currently housed in the basement of Barrow Primary School (See Appendix 1).

Earlier this year a parishioner asked Barrow Parish Council if these stones could be found a permanent home that would provide a suitable and dignified way of recognising the 'Fallen of Barrow'.

Barrow Parish Councillors' Kinder and Heyworth have met with the Head of Barrow



Primary School, who has agreed to donate to the Council a granite stone plaque that is currently on display on a wall in the school corridor and also stated that she would welcome the memorial stones currently in their basement being moved to a more suitable location.

4. Memorial Information Board and Stones:

It is envisaged that the donated plaque or a representation of it, along with suitable narrative, would be displayed on a Memorial Information Board in a prominent location in the cemetery.

Regarding the stones, consideration should be given to providing a dedicated and permanent location for them in the cemetery. It should be noted that the stones may need to be treated before they can be placed outside.

5. Financial considerations:

The cost of an information board depends on the size and material used; it would seem

prudent to budget £2,500 to cover the cost of a suitable board, installation, and delivery.

Borough Councillor Lee Street (Ribble Valley's Armed Forces Representative) has stated that grants may be available towards the costs associated with such a project.

The Barrow Action Group (BAG) have indicated they may consider funding the purchase and installation of the Memorial Information Board.



6. The Committee is Recommended:

To consider the report and decide if they wish to install a 'Fallen of Barrow' memorial Information Board in the cemetery and if a permanent location can be found for the stones currently located in Barrow Primary School.

"MY BRAVEST OFFICER."

"HIS MEN WOULD FOLLOW HIM ANYWHERE."

Mr. and Mrs. Hopwood, Barrow, are assured of the sympathy of every inhabitant of the village and district in the bereavement which has befallen them by the death of their youngest son, Sec.Lieut. Norman Hopwood, M. G. C. The blow fell on Monday, and was in the form of an official telegram. Subsequently, Major J. B. Smelter wrote :-

"I am deeply grieved to tell you your son was killed in action, yesterday, the 24th. He led his guns into action very bravely, and was doing extremely good work when a shell burst at his side, killing him instantaneously and the gunner who was with him. I brought his body out, together with another of his brother officers who fell at the same time, and, followed by all the officers of the Company, the Colonel of the Battalion, other officers, N. C. O's and men who knew him, we paid the last tribute and laid him to rest in a British Cemetery. A cross will be erected over his grave, which will mark his last resting place for all time. It is impossible to tell you the gloom it has cast over the whole battalion, in the loss of your son, for he was very popular amongst his brother officers, and his men so trusted him that they would follow him anywhere. My bravest officer, exceedingly good in hi work and in the mess he was the life of our party. The whole of my company join me in tendering ou deepest sympathy in your terrible loss. He fought bravely, and fell, and it can truly be said of himone of the bravest of all herces."

Twenty one years of age, Lieut. Hopwood had a winning personality. He was educated a Blackburn Grammar School, where he captained the cricket X1. His love for the summer game also found expression at Barrow, where he availed himself of every opportunity of practising. With all the members of the village club he was hail-fellow-well-met. Deceased had adopted the profession or medicine and dentistry and was articled to Mr. T. Forrest, Church Street. After vainly trying to enlis on several occasions, he was eventually accepted, and threw up his studies two years ago to follo many of his friends into the Army, and first saw service in Italy, reaching France last Spring.
