3. Report Back from Councillors (Information Only)

- a. The broken glass in the bus shelter has not yet been replaced. LCC has stated that their contractor has advised that it will be replaced this month.
- b. Cllr Brown will contact the Pickwick committee following requests to the Parish Council, from an electrical contractor, that his firm be considered in the installation and removal of the Xmas lights in the village.
- c. Vale Gardens has been power washed to remove algae on the walking areas and the loose coping stones have been secured.

4. To Review the ad hoc arrangements between various organisations/institutions with allocated Lengthsman time and Abbey Gardening Services contract

It was resolved that the Lengthsman/Abbey Gardening Services should only carry out works as contracted with and by the Parish Council. Should any organisations contact him to use his services then he needs to refer them to Cllr Brown and/or the Clerk. The Clerk is to correspond with Whalley in Bloom to advise them that

the Public Toilet storage area is the responsibility of RVBC not the Parish Council.
