Whilst we appreciate that work may cause some inconvenience, this will be kept to a minimum and you can help us ensure that the process runs smoothly:



Please keep a look out for our advance notice signs which will confirm when the work is intended to start and bear in mind that dates may be flexible, depending on unavoidable conditions such as extended periods of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.



Please move your vehicles to a safe location when we put the "No Parking" signs and cones out. You will be able to return your vehicle outside our working hours, but we need the road to be clear whilst we are working on the highway.



Please note that if your vehicle is left on the road, we will try to contact you initially, but if we are unable to contact you and the vehicle has to be towed away, unfortunately this may be at your cost.



Please keep your windows and doors closed, as there may be dust from our works.
