(PORTFIELD LANE, WHALLEY, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2019

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Portfield Lane, Whalley from its junction with A671 Whalley Road to its junction with Portfield Road in the borough of Ribble Valley.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0730 hours on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2019 until 1545 hours on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2019 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Portfield Lane – A671 Accrington Road – Portfield Road – Portfield Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent works to be carried out.
